- A few fatcs about the tournament
- There will be two opening matches in Category G/B21 Monday evening, July 8 at 7.00 p.m and 7.45 p.m
- The tournament will start on Tuesday morning, July 9 at 8.30 a.m
- All teams will play between 6 and 11 matches
- All matches last 2 x 15 minutes
- Finals last 2 x 20 minutes
- The teams will be divided into groups of 4 to 6
- All teams will play preliminary matches Tuesday and Wednesday
- The winning team and the runner-up (and possibly third place as well) of every group continue to the A-finals
- The other teams will go on to the B playoff
- The finals in B/G21-19 will be played Friday 7.00 p.m - 11.00 p.m.
- The other finals will be played Saturday 8 a.m -3.30 p.m.
- The oldest players play indoors in sports halls
- The youngest players play outdoors on grass fields (football boots may be used)
- ALL finals are played indoors
